Two new hydropower plants in Albania

EBRD lends €5.2 million to Hydro Power Plant of Korca (a Fidia Finanziaria and Edileurope joint venture) for two units generating 23 GWh per year

The EBRD is supporting private sector investment in renewable energy generation in Albania with a \in 5.2 million loan to the Hydro Power Plant of Korca sh.p.k., to finance the construction of two hydropower plants in the eastern part of the country.

Albania already generates almost all of its electricity from hydropower plants, but very little new capacity has been built in the last few years to keep up with the growing electricity demand, which is currently being satisfied with expensive imports. Rehabilitation of the hydropower sector and improvement of energy efficiency is one of the country's priorities.

With the support of the EBRD loan, Hydro Power Plant of Korca (an Albanian company owned by two Italian companies, Fidia Ambiente srl, which is part of Fidia Finanziaria spa, EdilEurope srl which is part of ADRE Group, and by the local company Xhemi sh.p.k.) will build two plants – Verbe-Selce 1 and 2 – due to become operational next year. With a combined capacity of 5 MW, the two plants will generate up to 23 GWh of electricity per year and help offset over 17,400 tonnes of CO_2 annually.

"The construction of the Verbe-Selce SHPP Cascade reaffirms the EBRD's great interest in renewable energy in Albania. This project will help improve security of energy supply in an area of the country with grid stability problems," said Fabio Serri, Head of the EBRD's Resident Office in Albania.

"We are enthusiastic about the EBRD's involvement in hydropower plants in Albania. The financial support of the EBRD represents an important endorsement and recognition of the quality of our investment and our commitment in the region. This project will set an excellent example of financially viable investments in renewables, we look forward to more projects in the Balkan region" said Claudio Barbano, president and CEO of EdilEurope.

"Fidia Finanziaria, through its subsidiary Fidia Ambiente, has been operating for many years in the renewable energy sector. This new initiative in Albania is part of a strategic plan that will involve further investments in renewable energy in the Balkan region," said Fabrizio Arengi Bentivoglio, Chairman and CEO of Fidia Finanziaria.
